Investiture Ceremony

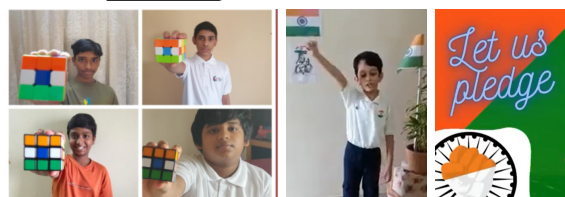

From Mandala Art to Mask Making, Performance Poetry to Soliloquy, Just a Minute to Debate, it was FUN all the way!

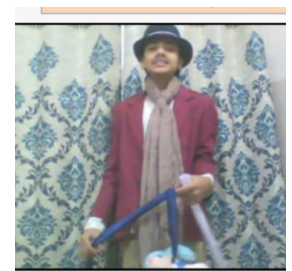

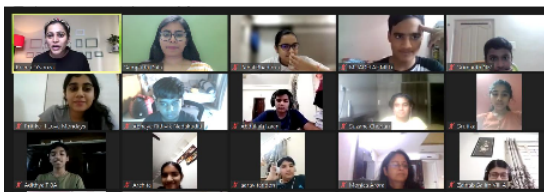

Children enjoyed folding papers and were thrilled to see their boats afloat.

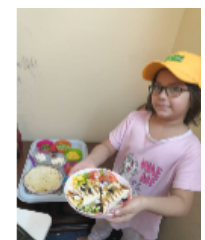

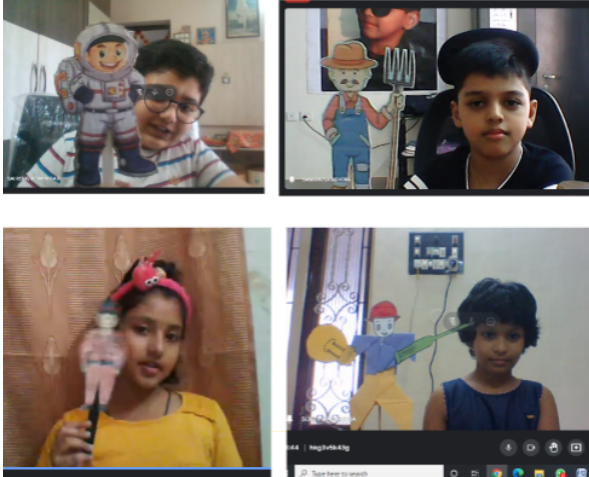

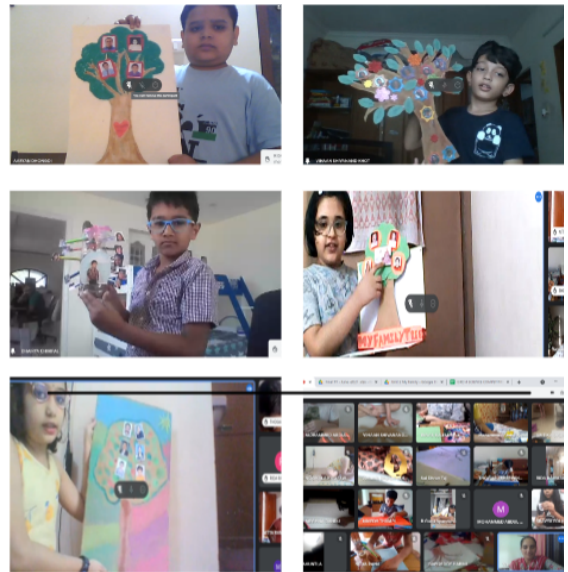

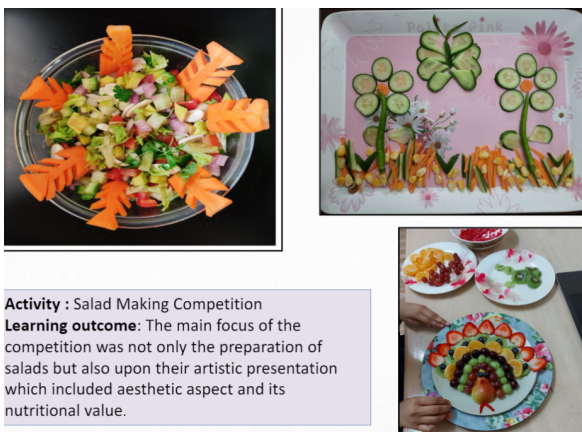
